Cabra Castle

Cabra Castle stands on 100 acres of gardens and parkland, with delightful views over the Cavan countryside, famous for its beautiful lakes. Formerly known as Cormey Castle, the history of the castle dates back to the pre-Cromwellian times of the 16th century. The property was bought in the early 19th century by Colonel Joseph Pratt who rebuilt it, renaming it as Cabra Castle. Its long legacy lends a mature, cultured air to the castle which can be felt by strolling through the castle’s magnificent hallways and stairwells. Experience this history when you enjoy an overnight stay on the castle grounds. The rooms are outfitted to the highest standards with every comfort and modern facilities. The bar and restaurant offer views of the countryside famous for its lakes and fishing, as well as Dun a Ri Forest Park.

It was also from Kilmainham that Irish convicts were deported to the Australian penal colonies. Famous inmates included Charles Stewart Parnell and Éamon de Valera, who was elected president of the Republic of Ireland in 1959. The prison's population soared during the famine years as starving Irish committed petty crimes in order to be fed. *Duration: Approximately 5 hours.* Please note a minimum of 15 passengers is required. Transportation is included.
